**DECISION TITLE: Disposal of CFRS Vehicles**

**Executive Summary:**  
 The purpose of this paper is to seek approval from the Police, Fire and Crime Commissioner for the disposal of vehicles in accordance with the Cumbria Fire & Rescue Service (CFRS) Fleet Strategy.

As part of its ongoing capital replacement programmes, CFRS regularly identifies fire appliances, specialist appliances, light vehicles, and equipment that are due for disposal. This paper outlines the assets and proposes appropriate disposal routes.

The disposal process is designed to be fair, transparent and aligns with the CFRS Asset Disposal Strategy. It also incorporates measures to mitigate the risk of inappropriate third-party use of the decommissioned assets.
