

## Staff of the Office of the Police, Fire & Crime Commissioner

- Statutory instrument 3050 (Elected Local Policing Bodies (Specified Information) Order 2011) states that all Offices of Police, Fire and Crime Commissioners must publish certain information about their staffing structure.
- 2. Within the Office of the Police, Fire and Crime Commissioner there are currently the following members of staff:
  - OPFCC Team 15 full time, 2 part time and 1 zero-hours
  - Estates Team 16 full time and 8 part time members of staff
  - A copy of both staff structures are available on the Commissioner's website in the <u>Your PFCC</u> Team section.
- 3. The gender breakdown of the OPFCC is 58.5% female and 41.5% male; and is broken down as:.
  - Estates 13 male 11 female
  - OPFCC 4 male 13 female
- 4. Staff members do not have to declare their ethnic background. Of those members who did staff declared they were White British, White Irish or White German.
- 5. Three members of staff have self-declared that they consider themselves to have a disability.
- 6. This information is up to date and accurate as of 30 June 2025. The information contained above is reviewed on an annual basis and any amendments published thereafter.
