



Staff of the Office of the Police, Fire & Crime Commissioner

1. Statutory instrument 3050 (Elected Local Policing Bodies (Specified Information) Order 2011) states that all Offices of Police, Fire and Crime Commissioners must publish certain information about their staffing structure.
2. Within the Office of the Police, Fire and Crime Commissioner there are currently the following members of staff:
 - OPFCC Team - 15 full time, 2 part time and 1 zero-hours
 - Estates Team – 16 full time and 8 part time members of staff
 - A copy of both staff structures are available on the Commissioner's website in the [Your PFCC Team](#) section.
3. The gender breakdown of the OPFCC is 58.5% female and 41.5% male; and is broken down as:.
 - Estates 13 male – 11 female
 - OPFCC 4 male – 13 female
4. Staff members do not have to declare their ethnic background. Of those members who did staff declared they were White British, White Irish or White German.
5. Three members of staff have self-declared that they consider themselves to have a disability.
6. This information is up to date and accurate as of 30 June 2025. The information contained above is reviewed on an annual basis and any amendments published thereafter.
